

Yellow devil hawkweed

Hieracium glomeratum

Asteraceae = Compositae, the sunflower family

Category: EDRR



Background:

- Invasive European hawkweed, plants outcompete native species
- Vegetatively reproduces with both rhizomes and stolons
- Wind dispersed seed
- Increases with grazing
- Found in open fields, mountain meadows and forest clearings, pastures, and mesic habitats

Description:

- Dandelion-like heads with yellow, ray (strap-like) flowers
- Flower stalk is short in **compact flower clusters**
- Leafless stem
- Leaves with short and stiff hairs on both sides
- Milky sap (latex) in stems and leaves
